



## **i-wareness<sup>®</sup> Teach & Test**

The i-wareness<sup>®</sup> Teach & Test is a comprehensive tool for testing employees' understanding of Security compliance. Through a combination of interactive modules, the Teach & Test tool provides your employees with one or two pages of security advice and guidance before testing their understanding and providing feedback on their responses. Modules are tailored to your organisation's requirements and targeted to differing employee audiences. Full reporting of employee results are collated for compliance, audit and additional reporting facilities.

### **The benefits**

The i-wareness<sup>®</sup> Teach & Test:

- Provides a highly dynamic, flexible and cost-effective approach to employee training
- Allows for multiple modules to be created for differing audience types and topics, for simultaneous publication
- Will be tailored to reflect your security and training objectives, whether these be learning, compliance certification or knowledge assessment
- Can be easily amended to reflect changes to the risk environment and/or campaign focus
- Is easy to use and manage in-house as it does not run through an LMS
- Provides full reporting facilities for compliance and auditing purposes
- Is a good indicator of the success of your communications campaigns
- Identifies gaps in employee knowledge and highlights hot topics for future campaign direction

### **The structure**

The i-wareness<sup>®</sup> Teach & Test typically contains fifteen pages of guidance and ten to fifteen questions. These are created to reflect both your training requirements and intended audience.

A number of options are available to ensure the tool meets your specific requirements, including:

- A structure that can accommodate 'teach only', 'test only' or combination of both
- The provision and set up for additional modules
- The option of creating bespoke Teach & Tests for specific target audiences
- Randomisation of questions
- The facility for the user to 'go back, re-read and re-try again'
- A bookmarking facility that allows employees to sign-in and sign-out of the Teach & Test without losing their place, thus enabling them to complete the test at their own convenience and pace

- Feedback following each question and answer, with the option of linking back to the Knowledge Zone for further information
- A final results page to contain an employee's final score with the opportunity to provide any additional guidance or security messages to continue the campaign momentum
- The option of configuring the Teach & Test as a quiz

Highly flexible, the i-wareness® Teach & Test can also be easily amended to reflect changes to the evolving risk environment or focus of the communications campaign. For example, throughout the first three-month period the Teach & Test modules may emphasise the threat of social engineering, phishing and other types of fraud. For the next quarter, the focus may be to promote physical and access security, educating employees on threats such as tailgating, or the importance of reporting unidentified visitors.

The modules can also be tailored for differing audience types. This is particularly important as each identified audience type will have different motivators, objectives and levels of security understanding.

## The results

Having completed the Teach & Test modules, employees are presented with their score and test history where they have completed earlier modules.

Results are gathered and can be used for compliance, audit and additional reporting facilities.

A breakdown of responses is available to identify strengths and weaknesses in your employees' knowledge and understanding of security good practices. The results are also a strong indicator of the success of targeted communications campaigns and are

highly influential in directing the security awareness programme going forward.

Results can be split according to your business and security objectives. Examples of typical splits can be by employee, by question, by department, by country or by region.
